Deeper Devotion

The Obstructions to Unity

Our world is filled with chaos and division. Humanity is split along lines of ethnicity, religion, geography, language, skin colour, and socio-economic status. It leads me to wonder, is genuine unity possible? Over the past two decades, we have witnessed a few initiatives aimed at fostering unity within our community. However, despite these efforts, we have not yet reached a point where we can unequivocally label ourselves as a united and cohesive community. In this article, I hope to shed light on some of the barriers hindering unity in our community.

In John 17:20–22, Jesus prayed for believers to become one, mirroring the unity within the Godhead. He achieved this unity by breaking the dividing wall of hostility between the Jews and the Gentiles in his flesh through his sacrifice on the cross (Ephesians 2:13–15). Jesus has made this unity a reality! However, let's admit that practically speaking, achieving such unity in our human nature is extremely challenging. Why is this the case?

I want to address two obstacles that hinder our unity. The first can be found in the story of the twelve spies sent by Moses to scout Canaan. The division among the twelve spies led to the entire congregation rebelling against Moses and God (Numbers 14:1-4). Two spies, Joshua and Caleb, saw things from "God's perspective," while the other ten spies viewed things from a "human perspective" (Numbers 14:1-4). This behavior was a manifestation of sins like selfishness, self-seeking, and a refusal to accept God's plans for their lives.

Do similar conflicting perspectives and sins bring division in our community?

The second obstacle is reflected in the account of Ananias and Sapphira in Acts 5. They deceitfully kept a portion of the proceeds from the sale of their property, presenting only a part while pretending generosity (Acts 5:3, 9). This was undeniably an act of hypocrisy. They wanted to show the Church that they were sacrificing their property as Barnabas and others had done. But in reality, they kept some for themselves. Their action was meant to portray themselves as good and godly, but their hearts were far from true goodness and godliness and even from God! I believe that hypocrisy, or showing off, is a prominent sin in our community that hinders the unity that comes from the Holy Spirit.

It is my hope and prayer that God will grant us forgiveness of our sins of selfishness, rejection of His plans, and the hypocrisy that disrupts the unity we ought to maintain in the community of Christ.


Satan always hates Christian Fellowship; it is his policy to keep Christian apart.


